Breakout Rooms to choose:

Breakout Room 1 (ukr) Ukraine on the Path to the EU: Citizens' Opinions and Hopes

Leading question of the breakout room: How is Ukraine moving towards the EU, what's the attitude of Ukrainian society, and how is the development of common values going? Ukraine follows an already long-lasting path towards EU accession, without knowing when and how it will end. In this breakout room we want to take a closer look at the relationship between the EU and Ukraine and develop ideas on how to tighten it.

Breakout Room 2 (eng) Towards a European Identity

Questions of identity are always highly sensitive and personal, but the way we feel or not feel can lead to political consequences. Especially since Brexit we hear that the European project lacks the support of its citizens over and over again. In this breakout room we want to discuss where this lack comes from and develop ideas of how to strengthen European identity.

Breakout Room 3 (eng) European Citizens from East and West

Even though the fall of the iron curtain in 1989 released tensions in the relationship between Eastern and Western Europe and removed physical barriers to exchange and cooperation, we still observe that prejudices and sometimes ignorance remain driving factors of how we perceive our fellow European Countries. In this breakout room we want to dive deep into each other's perceptions, establish common ground, and discuss ideas on how to dismantle persisting barriers.
