Open Government Partnership (OGP)



+ **International platform** that promotes governments to be more open, transparent and responsive to the needs of citizens



+ **Founded in 2011** by eight governments and nine civil society leaders

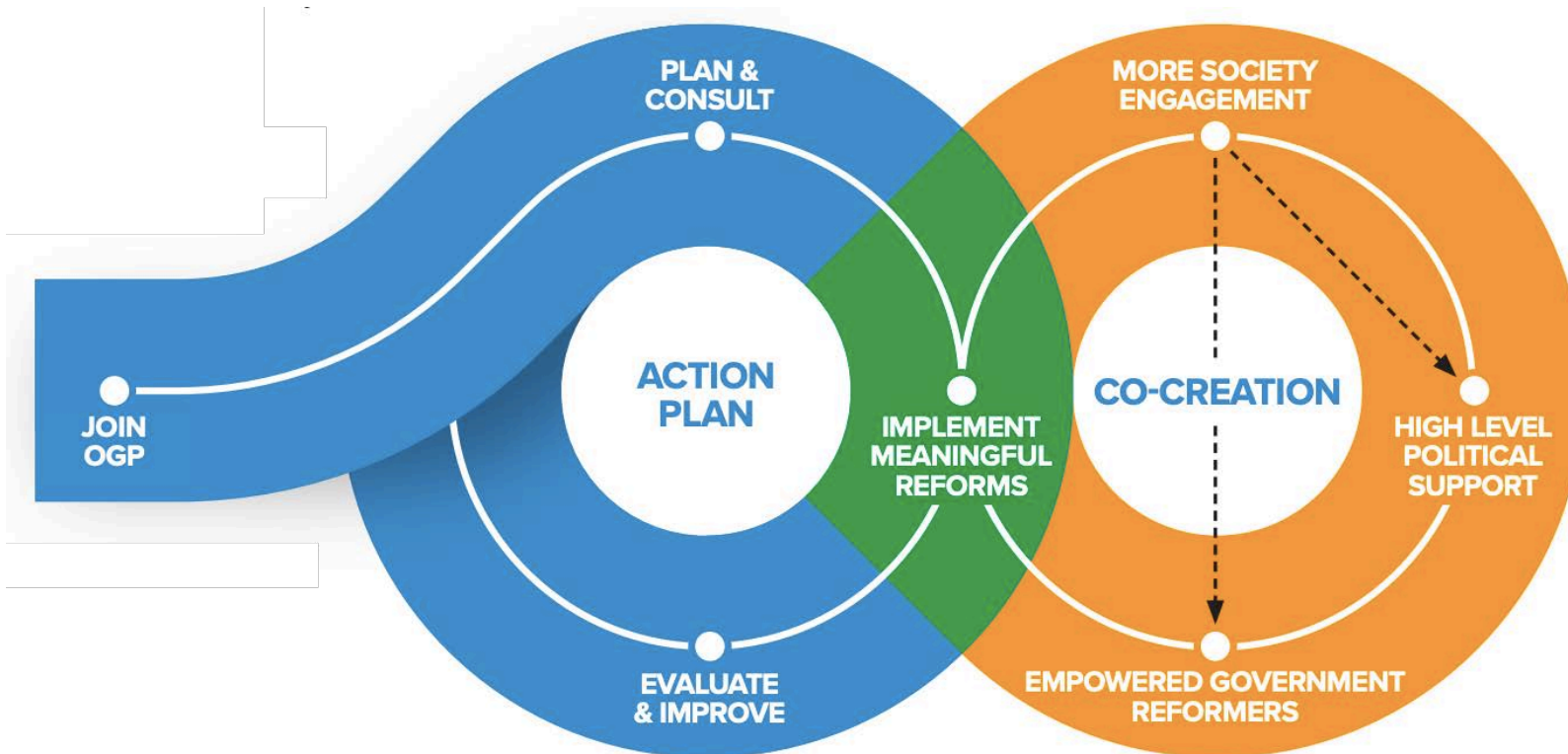


+ **Currently composed of 78 national and 20 local governments (soon +50 new ones), and thousands of civil society organizations,** which have jointly developed more than 4,095 commitments



+ **Governed by an Steering Committee** made up of 11 governments and 11 civil society leaders

Our Origin

- + Launched in 2016 as Subnational Pilot Program
- + Fifteen (15) inaugural members



Our Expansion

- + Renamed OGP Local in 2018
- + Five (5) new members



Our Evolution

- + Newly approved local strategy at 2019 OGP Summit
- + Implementation of strategy beginning with intake of up to fifty (50) new members

Kaduna State, Nigeria

Eyes and Ears Program

- + Citizen participation program and citizen monitoring of infrastructure projects
- + Progress and problems can be disclosed through various platforms
- + Implementation of the Open Contracting Data Standard

La Libertad, Perú

Mapping of water and sanitation providers

- + Web platform reports coverage and quality of water for human consumption
- + Allows citizens to submit reports on water and sanitation problems
- + Increased trust in water quality

Madrid, España

DECIDE MADRID

- + Citizen participation portal
- + Citizens can get to know, support and create projects and allocate public resources
- + Replicable platform using free platform: CONSUL

South Cotabato, Philippines

Covid-19 Contact Tracing System

- + Multi-stakeholder consultative design process including civil society, academia and experts
- + Ongoing oversight council including civil society, academics, government and Human Rights Commission
