# Open Government Partnership (OGP)

 International platform that promotes governments to be more open, transparent and responsive to the needs of citizens


- + Founded in 2011 by eight governments and nine civil society leaders
- + Currently composed of 78 national and 20 local governments (soon +50 new ones), and thousands of civil society organizations, which have jointly developed more than 4,095 commitments
- + Governed by an Steering Committee made up of 11 governments and 11 civil society leaders

### **Our Origin**

- Launched in 2016 as Subnational Pilot Program
- Fifteen (15) inaugural members

## **Our Expansion**

- Renamed OGP Local in 2018
- + Five (5) new members

## **Our Evolution**

- Newly approved local strategy at 2019 OGP Summit
- Implementation of strategy beginning with intake of up to fifty (50) new members

- Multi-stakeholder consultative design process including civil society, academia and experts
- + Ongoing oversight council including civil society, academics, government and Human Rights Commission
